Simplifying Store Networks

With 122 Arby's restaurants running on multiple legacy network devices with no failover network to maintain high availability, KBP Inspired wanted to modernize its in-store technology. The primary goal was to introduce a next-generation platform across all sites while consolidating on a single vendor to reduce costs and simplify operations.

The company selected PDI's as-a-service platform that features:

- A next-generation firewall
- A resilient design with automatic failover for high availability
- A 24/7/365 managed services team with deep industry expertise



Recognizing the Value of an MNSP

After a pilot program at a few sites, KBP Inspired and PDI began upgrading the networks at all the restaurant locations. One key to success was the ability to control the network design from the start, with expert help designing a fluid architecture that could meet needs the company hadn't even anticipated. The flexible network solutions include PDI Firewall as a Service, Wi-Fi as a Service, and 5G as a Service. In addition, the company has deployed PDI MDR (Managed Detection and Response) to proactively monitor end points and help avoid cyberthreats such as ransomware.

The firewall helps secure network traffic while the indoor Wi-Fi services on Aruba access points help keep both employees and guests happy. A small number of restaurants that were experiencing significant issues with local ISPs are now using 5G capabilities with the assurance of a 100% 5G signal. Key benefits of the upgrade include:

- More consistent and reliable network services
- Scalable technology that can grow along with the business
- Proactive 24/7/365 monitoring and support from PDI
